## ADMC CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS 2019

### 1.0 OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

#### General Regulations:

All events contained in the individual Championships as listed below, will form the Overall ADMC Club Championship 2019 except for the Marshals Championship

There will be awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Marshals Championship.

It is a requirement, to Marshal on an ADMC organised or run event, or on an event to which ADMC has been invited to attend, to be eligible for 1<sup>st</sup> Overall (Club Champion), 2<sup>nd</sup> Overall or 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall, Top Lady and Under 21s Champion.

Winners of Overall Awards (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Overall Club Championship) will **not** be eligible for individual Championship Awards. This does not include the winner of the Top Lady Award and Under 21 Award.

All individual Championships, including the U-21 Championship, will carry 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> overall awards except for the Top Lady Award and Under 21 Award.

Additional Trophies/Awards may be presented at the Annual Awards Ceremony at the discretion of the General Committee/Board of Directors.

Winners of a Perpetual Award should be aware that these awards will be available for photographs on the night, but will be retained by the Club.

In the event of a "tied score" at the end of the season in either an Overall or Class section of this Championship, points scored in the first, or subsequent, round(s) of said Class will decide the winner.

It may prove necessary to change the published date/venue of an event. Should this prove necessary, this information will be made available as soon as is possible via the Club Website, Facebook Page, email or the event organiser(s). It is advised that anyone wishing to enter any of the events listed within this Championship contact the event organiser(s) at the time of submitting an entry. Date, venue or other such pertinent changes to any event are at the discretion of the Principal Organiser for the event.

Overall and Class specific Annual Awards shall only be available to Fully Paid-up Members of ADMC. For the purpose of these Regulations, Membership commences on 1 January 2019 and **ANY** Member is eligible for Club points following this Fully Paid-up Membership, from the date of joining.

#### FASTEST TIME by an ADMC MEMBER at FINTRAY AWARD;

To be competed for by any competitor who is an ADMC Member on the day of any of the events. All times, including Practice and Timed Runs to be considered.

### 5.0 OVERALL SPEED CHAMPIONSHIP

The overall Speed Championship will be decided by the best SIX scores from the Sprint and Hillclimb Championships, with at least one score from each discipline to qualify.

## 6.0 POINTS CALCULATION

Points will reflect the actual performance within that Class by an ADMC Member, and therefore **all** finishing positions will be considered, irrespective of Club, for the allocation of points. Points are therefore awarded as follows

1st in Class - 20 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> in Class – 18 points, 3rd in Class - 17 pts, with Points decreasing by one point until 19<sup>th</sup> position and below where 1 Point is awarded to every starter. Where there are 3 or less Competitors in a Class, half points will be awarded, plus an additional point awarded.

Additional points will be awarded in each Class as follows: Points, up to a maximum of 4 additional points, will be awarded to each Competitor in a Class taking into account the number of Competitors finishing behind that Competitor, as follows:

Number of finishers in class	2	3	4	5	
Five or more finishers	4	3	2	1	0
Four finishers	3	2	1	0	0
Three finishers	2	1	0	0	0
Two finishers	1	0	0	0	0

Further points will be added to the score of any ADMC Member gaining a Top 3 overall placing and shall be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Overall 3 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> Overall - 2 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall - 1 point

### COMPETITORS and MARSHALS to NOTE.

It is becoming increasingly difficult to source the information necessary to award points for ADMC Championship scoring events. With this in mind, it will be necessary for Competitors and Marshals to inform the Championship Co-Ordinator (currently George Anderson) of **ALL** events Contested or Marshalled at, in order to ensure the relevant points awarded. Proof of participation may be required. When making your claim for points, please give details of the Event and a relevant Event Organiser or Official who can be contacted to supply supportive evidence.

## 7.0 The OVERALL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

In the Club Championship each competitor (driver or navigator) may count all scores, except where indicated otherwise. To qualify for the Overall Championship, Top Ladies Award and Under 21 Award, Competitors must have acted as a **Track** Marshal on an ADMC event, or event where ADMC have been invited to marshal. The acting as an Official by a Competitor may be acceptable at the discretion of the Committee.

In the Speed Championship the best 6 scores from Sprint and Hillclimb Events will count, with a minimum of one score to count from each discipline

**The UNDER 21 CHAMPIONSHIP.**

This Trophy will be presented annually to the highest placed competitor in the Overall Club Championship who was under 21 on the 1st January of the championship year.

Other Awards may be presented at the discretion of the General Committee/Board of Directors

**8.0 MARSHAL CHAMPIONSHIP (OPEN TO ADMC MEMBERS ONLY)**

Points can be scored for attendance as a **TRACK MARSHAL** on an ADMC organised or run event, or on an event to which ADMC has been invited to attend

Two levels of points can be earned:

- 3 points for actively participating in "setting up days" or recognised Training Days.
- 5 points on each event day as **TRACK MARSHAL**.

**9.0 TIE BREAK PROCEDURE**

If a tie occurs on an event, competitors will be awarded appropriate Championship points irrespective of any tiebreak formula applied by the event organisers.

In the event of a tie in the Overall and various discipline Championships, the Competitor scoring points soonest in the season shall take precedence. Should there be no clear winner, a tie shall be declared.

**10.0 CHAMPIONSHIP STATUS**

The various championship tables will be updated regularly on the Website and Facebook Pages, and by email.

**11.0 AWARDS**

Event Trophies and/or Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each event. Annual and Championship Trophies/Awards will be presented at the Annual Awards Presentation. At the discretion of the General Committee additional Awards may be presented to Club Members.
