Supplementary Regulations

1. Aberdeen and District Motor Club Ltd (ADMC) will organise a national status B sprint event at Grampian Kart Club, Boyndie 'Drome on 29/30<sup>th</sup> Jun 2019

2. This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

3. MSA Permit No:TBA

4. The event is open to all fully elected members of ADMC , all members of Motorsport UK Scottish Association of Motor Sports Clubs and Competitors entered in the Championships detailed later.

All competitors must produce a valid competition licence and club membership card at sign on and the appropriate vehicle documentation is to be available.

5. The event will be rounds of the 2019 Aberdeen & District Motor Club Championship

Guyson Scottish Championship

Highland Speed Championship

6. Scrutineering will be carried out "in situ" and will start at 07:30

7. Practice will start at approx. 09:00 on both days.

A driver's briefing will be carried out by the Clerk of the Course prior to start of practice.

The Method of Timing will be electronic, and the start signal will be a green light. The timing will be activated by a light beam. Competitors are required to have a timing strut in accordance with S10.9

Any competitor not signed on by 10:00 may be excluded

8. The circuit, which has a tarmacadam surface, is 825m long and consists of 1.8 laps run in a clockwise direction. The finish line will be indicated by signs.

- A7 Classic and Thoroughbred Cars (period defined) PR HSC Class
- A8 Marque Road Sports Cars

A9 Scottish MX5 Hillclimb and Sprint Register Cars

Division B Modified Cars

- B1 Modified Saloon Cars up to 1400cc
- B2 Modified Saloon Cars over 1400cc and up to 2000cc
- B3 Modified Saloon Cars over 2000cc
- B4 Modified Sports Cars up to 1400cc
- B5 Modified Sports Cars over 1400cc and up to 1700cc
- B6 Modified Sports Cars over 1700cc

Division C Competition Cars

- C0 Saloon Libre
- C1 Sports Libre up to 1400cc
- C2 Sports Libre over 1400cc and up to 1800cc
- C3 Sports Libre over 1800cc
- C4 Racing Cars up to 1100cc
- C5 Racing Cars over 1100cc and up to 1600cc
- C6 Racing Cars over 1600cc

Division D Classic and Thoroughbred Cars (period defined)

- D1 Classic & Thoroughbred road cars
- D2 Classic & Thoroughbred modified cars
- D3 Classic & Thoroughbred competition cars

9. Cars will start in class order and will start singly. Double entries will be accommodated as directed by the paddock marshall.

10. Time permitting and at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, Competitors will be offered two practise runs. Competitors may walk the course.

11. Competition numbers must be displayed in accordance with regulation S9.2.5. Identification numbers may be available to purchase at signing on.

12. There are no pit areas provided.

13. Judges of Fact - The Chief Scrutineer will be the Judge in respect of vehicle eligibility. The Environmental Scrutineer will be the Judge in respect of Sound.

14. There will be no television coverage of this event.

15. The following prizes will be awarded

FTD - Fastest Time of the Day, not eligible for class award

Fastest Road Car - not eligible for class award

Fastest Modified Car - not eligible for class award

1<sup>st</sup> in Class – Fastest time in Class

2<sup>nd</sup> in Class – where there are more than 5 starters in the class (subject to SR 16)

3<sup>rd</sup> in Class – where there are more than 11 starters in the class (subject to SR16)

16. The maximum number of entries is 80 and the minimum number is 50. Should any of the above figures not be reached, the Organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.

Entries will be accepted by order of receipt, and at the discretion of the organisers.

17. Entries open on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May and close at noon on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019
